On the morning of 9/11/2001, the high-jacked Flight 93 crashed into a field near Shanksville, PA, killing the 40 innocents on board. "Let's Roll" are the last words via cell phone by Todd Beamer, one of the passengers who bravely stormed the hijackers in the cockpit, and helped to prevent the terrorists from targeting yet another Washington DC site.

The Memorial Design

In 2005, following a yearlong international competition comprising over 1,000 submissions, a jury consisting of project partners and industry professionals selected the "Circle of Embrace" by Paul Murdoch Architects as the winning design for the Memorial.

The creation of the Flight 93 National Memorial is an historic opportunity to honor the citizen heroes and to share the story of their courage.
